

Little Acorns

Hauxton's very own Baby and Toddler Group 'Little Acorns' was established in January and has drawn together a total of 26 local families from Hauxton, Harston, Shelford and other nearby villages over the five months that it's been running. It's enabled parents and carers from our the local area to get to know one another and helped develop a real sense of community.

A number of Hauxton residents kindly donated toys to the group which the tots enjoy exploring each week - we have a large area with soft play mats and various sensory toys for the babies, whilst the toddlers and older children can enjoy the pop up tent, ride on bikes, hula hoops, foam hop-scotch, dressing up clothes and weekly craft activities.

Adults enjoy cakes, cups of tea/coffee and adult company. In addition to this weekly format, the children have enjoyed a few one-off activities: messy play, soap making, an easter egg hunt and peppermint creams making, and on 28 March the mums enjoyed a pop up jewellery sale.
